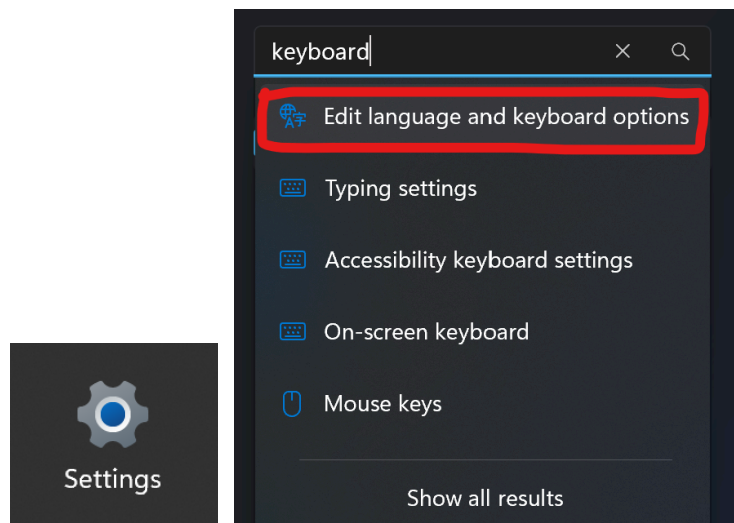
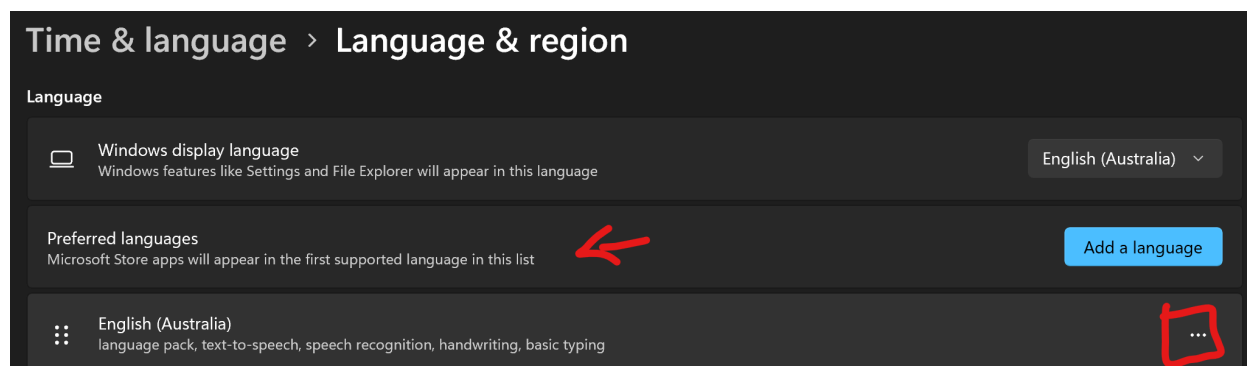


How to use accents in your computer keyboard

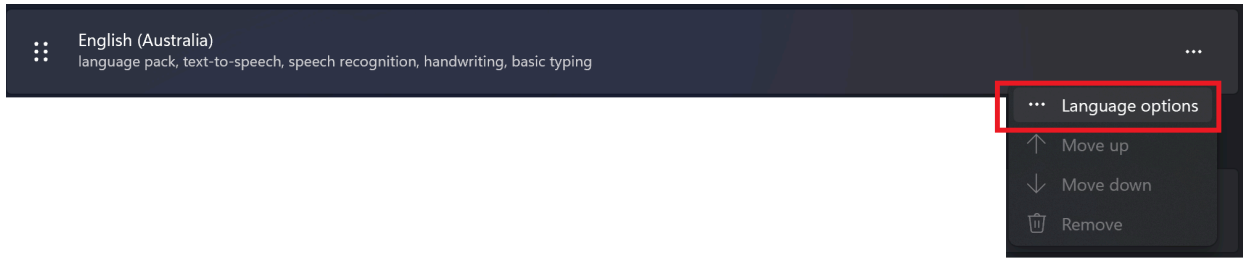
To use accents it is necessary to install the “United-States International” keyboard. This keyboard is compatible with all systems, so it can be installed on your computer. The process varies from system to system, but in general “**settings**” will have an option about **keyboard**. [Type “keyboard” or “languages” in the search space.]



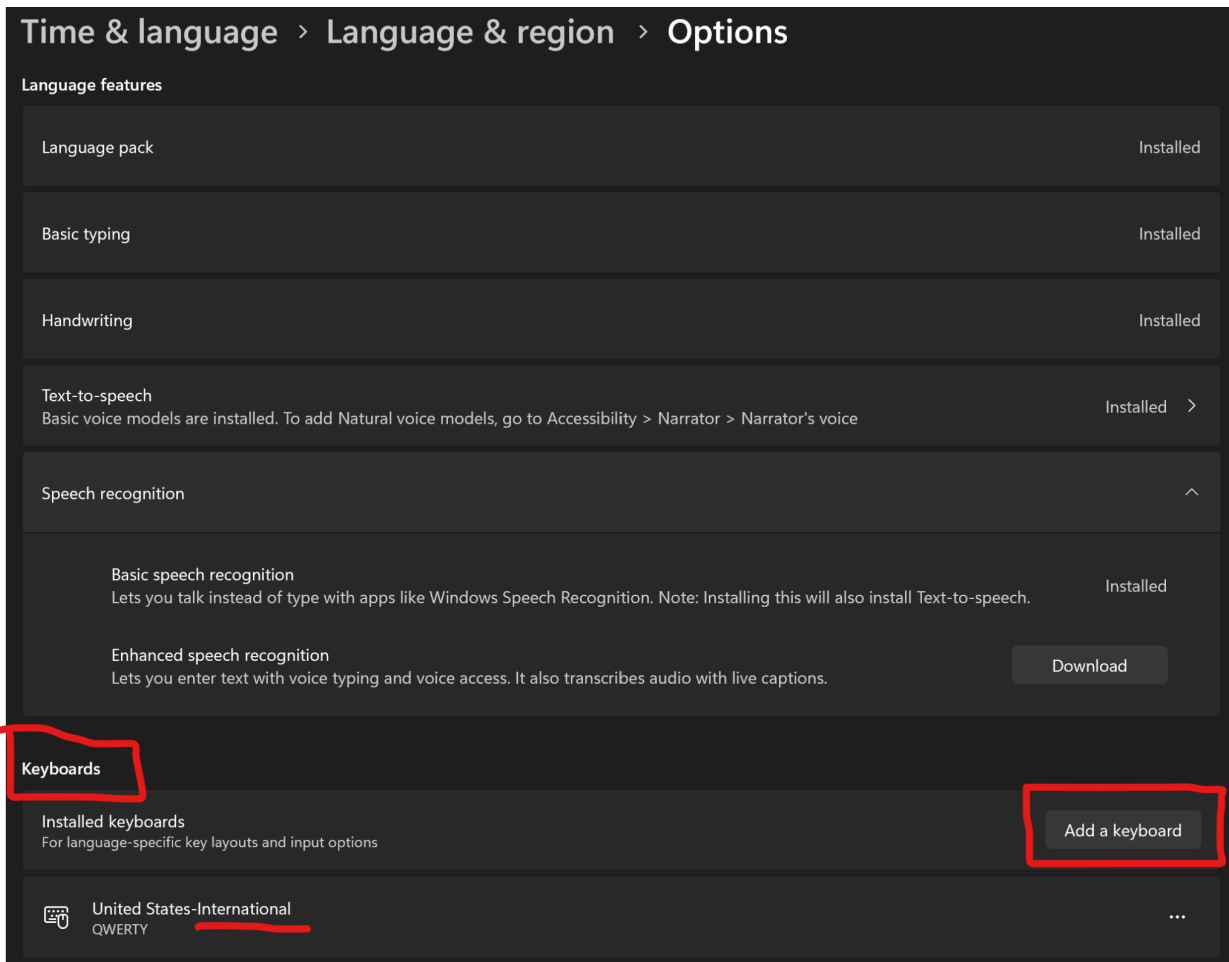
In “Language & Region”, you will have the languages you use on your computer. In mine, for example, I use English (Australia).



Look for a place to see more settings / more options. In this case, it’s the three dots: “... Language options”



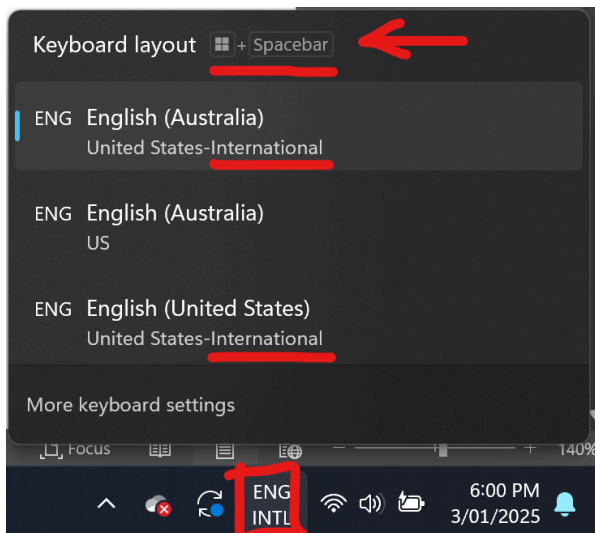
Here you will find the keyboard options. What we need to find is one that says “International”.



In my case, I use United States-International. You can add the keyboard in “add a keyboard”.

Depending on what you use your computer for, you may have several different keyboards. This example below has 3 keyboards. To see the keyboards, find the languages option which is usually near the clock, in the bottom right corner. To switch between one keyboard and another, you can click on the [ENG INTL] language option and select the keyboard you want. To generate accents, it has to be one that ends in “International”. In the case below, we can see

that there is a shortcut: the Windows key + spacebar. This way it switches between keyboards automatically.



Each operating system (Windows 10, Windows 11, Mac, etc.) will have a slightly different way of adding the keyboard, but all systems have this option.

If you have difficulties, try asking chatGPT, saying your **operating system**.

For example: *"I have a Mac Book Air com chip M2 / I have an Apple MacBook Pro I bought in 2020 / I have an Inspiron 16 Plus com Windows 11 and I would like to install the "United States - International" keyboard so that I can use the accents of the Portuguese language. Guide me step by step."*

If you don't know what your computer is, go to "settings" and look for "system" or "about".
